



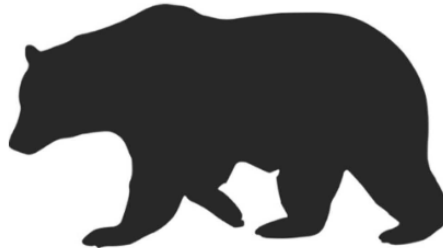

Please be aware Bears are now Active in the
Community

*Please Note - There is a mama with 2 cubs and a yearling that
have been spotted hanging around*



If you see a Bear:

- Do not try to get closer to the bear for a better look or picture;
- Make sure the bear has a clear escape route – don't corner a bear;
- Always watch the bear and slowly back away until the bear is out of site, get inside, if you are near a building or vehicle;
- Leave the area if you are berry picking, hiking, waking, camping, jogging or cycling;
- If the bear does not get close to you, slowly back away talking to the bear in a quiet monotone voice;

Report bear sightings in residential areas by phoning the BC Conservation Officer Service (COS) at 1-877-952-7277 and report to Cayoose Creek Band front desk at (250) 256 – 4136 ext. 201.

Reminders:

- Do not put out Garbage until the day of Garbage pick-up;
- Keep all household garbage in containers;
- Wrap smelling items in newspaper and freeze until disposal;
- Burn out grease from barbeques and clean out grease traps after each use;
